

Don't be a Spock – Adjust your monitor height



Spock's monitor location may lead to discomfort



Uhura's monitor is positioned much better

Position the top of your monitor at or slightly below seated eye height



Favor a slightly lower monitor height if you:

1. Work with hardcopy
2. View through bifocals or progressive lenses or
3. Look at the keyboard when typing.
